I can wear whatever clothes I am comfortable in.

I should wear comfortable shoes as I may do lots of walking or dancing!

I can get there in the car, on the bus, walk or ride my bike.

If I have an Accessible Parking Permit, I can park out the front of the festival.

When I get to the festival there will be lots of people there. I need to stay close to my family or carer.

- **listen to music at the venues.**

- **watch circus performers.**

I can plan which shows I want to see on the Folk Festival app or by using the Festival Program.
